GENERAL MEETING

A general membership meeting is scheduled at **4:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 24, 2008**. The meeting will be held at the clubhouse with the usual Sunday potluck to follow. It's a great opportunity to get out and meet your fellow members some of whom may become good friends. We'll have some fun and eat great food! There are three (3) items on the agenda:

- ◇ Purchase of a 40-foot cargo container (purchase over \$1,000 dollars)
- ◇ Purchase of a 3-D mammoth target for the 1,000,000 B.C. shoot (purchase over \$1,000 dollars)
- ◇ The fate of the Wednesday Night 3-D Shoots

3D CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP SHOOT

Since it was so popular last year, we are once again offering a **28-target 3D Club Championship** (14 3D targets mixed with 14 paper or foam bail-mounted targets) in addition to the regulation NFAA round club championship. A **\$5.00** fee per person for each shoot date covers the cost of scorecards and targets. Awards for all categories will be given out at our annual awards dinner. Since this is a Club Shoot, only members are eligible for awards. You must shoot and submit scores at least **two** of the following dates to qualify. Remember to indicate your shooting class (gender, age group, style, etc.) on your scorecard. Or if you prefer, bring your family and friends and just have some fun shooting.

March 9th, Sunday

May 10th, Saturday (following the workparty)

July 13th, Sunday

September 14th, Sunday

\$5.00 per person

Starts 9:00 am

Target take down by 5:00 pm

Please, join us and bring something to share at the Sunday evening potluck/BBQ after the target take down.

We will need volunteers to help set up the morning of the shoot and to help take down the targets afterwards.

Don't forget that you can shoot a regulation NFAA round for the "original" club championship any time. We had very poor participation last year with only a handful of members submitting scores. You can submit as many scores as you want, but you need to have at least three 28-target rounds shot in the company of at least two other archers (sign off on each other's scorecards). And, if you shoot the State Field Championship or the Regional Field Championship, the field and hunter rounds will count as two of the three scores required to be eligible for the Club Championship. Make sure that you indicate on your scorecards which you shoot first, 14 field or 14 hunter, and provide your shooting class (gender, age group, style, etc.). 2008 STATE FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP

This year, CBH/SAA is contemplating changing the format of the field championship to be a one-day shoot (14 field targets, 14 hunter targets, 14 animal targets) taking place simultaneously at multiple venues on Sunday, June 8. The Board has agreed to offer our range as one of the venues. The Board has also agreed to offer to be a venue for the Target 900 Championship in September. More details as they become available.
