## NFAA RANGE INSPECTION

Our range is going to be inspected by a representative of the NFAA on the 15<sup>th</sup> of March. We were one of only a few ranges to have garnered a 5-Star rating from the NFAA last year.

The SFA range will be evaluated on a point system with points being awarded for specific features that are present— Things such as cleanliness, wide paths, bow racks, benches, etc. You can view the entire evaluation form to see what the inspector will be looking for at the NFAA website: (<http://www.nfaa-archery.org/depot/documents/4908-20071105-Outdoor%20Range%20Inspection%20Form.pdf>) (tinyURL <http://tinyurl.com/bhdafx>). There will be copies at the clubhouse for those who do not have a computer.

One of the items the NFAA will look at is if we have the minimum number of Club Members who are also NFAA Members. If you are a NFAA member, please contact the board so that we can list you as a member to meet our requirements for the Club's NFAA association status. We need at least 5 Club Members (a household counts as one membership) to also be NFAA Members and the range gets extra points for a 50% or 100% membership rate.
